Wahlburgers is a casual dining burger restaurant and bar franchise concept started by Mark Wahlburg and brothers Donnie and Paul. This challenging project included working closely with multiple architects and builders to fabricate and install seven different lighted signs, both exterior and interior. Sign types included lighted channel letters, the circular "W"s and an awesome 17 foot-long green canopy with 'show' lights. Brunner - Wall Graphic

Our friends at <u>Brunner</u>, an agency that drives success using creativity, data science, and technology, needed a quick solution as part of its office was under construction and they were set to host a holiday party. Spark jumped in and printed a stone wall graphic that was placed around an existing TV. The result: a pop-up stone hearth with fireplace on screen.



Total Energy - Logo Design and Lobby Sign

We worked with <u>Total Energy Resources</u>, an energy company serving commercial, industrial and residential customers, to redesign their logo and to then adorn their office with a brand new lobby sign. We printed their new logo on high quality vinyl, adhered it to white acrylic and used brushed aluminum hardware to stand the sign off the wall to provide more dimension.

Longwood at Oakmont - Wayfinding Signage

Longwood at Oakmont called Spark to tackle a large sign project that included rebranding existing wayfinding or directional signage and adding new post and panel signs. Sign types included building names, directional, and road signs. This is a phased project and we'll be back out at the beautiful senior care community in the Spring to complete the project.



North Way Christian Community - Wall Graphics

Our friends at North Way Christian Community are set to open a new location in the Beaver Valley and we recently placed large vinyl wall graphics in several areas to enhance directional signage and let prospective members find their way around the new building. Other projects on site include temporary window graphics, parking signage, a KIDS ministry sign, and yard signs to spread the word about the new church.



Chapman Westport - Lighted Entrance Sign



We have been serving tenants at the Chapman Westport business park for months, and our lead client, Chapman Properties, asked us to build and install a large entrance sign. Chapman Westport is a 300-acre Class-A Business Park located three miles from the Pittsburgh International Airport. The lighted channel letters were 27" tall, with the total span of the sign being 39 feet.
